This value is calculated as a dissolved concentration for an appropriate comparison to the numeric water quality criteria, which are also in the dissolved form. Consistent with Georgia EPD, non-detectable effluent concentrations are not translated into Calculated Receiving Water Concentrations.

 5 Numeric Water Quality Criteria is the maximum concentration of a parameter (calculated at a default hardness of mpd. as calculated receiving waterbody that will be protective of the designated use per Georgia EPD's rules and regulations. Calculated Receiving Water Concentrations less than these criteria are protective of the waterbody.

 5 Acute (short-term) water quality criterion shown is for Hexavalent Chromium.

 5 The numeric water quality criterion shown is for Hexavalent Chromium.
